13 WHEREAS, the resolution did not describe the
14 specific section to be named; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That a three-mile section of U.S.
17 Highway 80 commencing at the easternmost boundary of the
18 section named in honor of Marie Foster and continuing three
19 miles east is designated in honor of Mrs. Amelia Platts
20 Boynton-Robinson.

22 officials are requested to place and maintain signs or markers
23 as provided in this resolution.
