BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That state-supported institutions of higher education and community and technical colleges in the state are encouraged to waive out-of-state tuition for those dependents of Alabama disabled veterans who are affected by Act 2017-349 and who enroll in the institution or college.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this 10 resolution be provided to each institution and college so that 11 they may know of our intent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, in turn, each institution and college notify the Chair of the Senate Finance and Taxation Education Committee, the Chair of the House Ways and Means Education Committee, and the Commissioner of the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs of its intent to waive out-of-state tuition pursuant to this resolution.
