WHEREAS, commendations are extended to Cameron Luke Ratliff, known nationally as Alabama basketball's premier superfan, who led the way in galvanizing the student body and The University community into one of the nation's most active college basketball fanbases; when the team cut down the nets after winning the conference championship, Luke was given a piece by the coaching staff as a symbol of his importance to the program; special condolences are offered to his friends and family, as Luke tragically passed away shortly after the conclusion of the team's season; and
