1 it to their own families, and potentially sacrificing their 2 own lives; and

3 WHEREAS, it is medically accepted that individuals 4 who suddenly experience severe trauma while engaged in combat, 5 or who live or work in life-threatening environments for 6 prolonged periods of time, often develop post-traumatic stress 7 disorder, a biopsychosocial brain disease that can have 8 debilitating health effects for decades; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE LEGISLATURE OF 10 ALABAMA, That we promote the enactment of legislation to 11 implement a \$1,000 Alabama Income Tax Credit for licensed 12 nurses who can attest to providing care and support of 13 COVID-19 patients in any and all clinical environments for any 14 period of time during the calendar year 2020, 2021, or both.
