1 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

3 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the passage and approval of this Act, the Chief

Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of

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SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

| 9 | SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General |
| 10 | Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the |
| 11 | appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the |
| 12 | effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is |
| 13 | essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this |
| 14 | Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative |
| 15 | session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its |
| 16 | passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper |
| 17 | administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, |
| 18 | an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the |
| 19 | immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in |
| 20 | full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. |
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
