9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE ARKANSAS
10 COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING;

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON LAW
15 ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
23 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
24 and Training, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
25 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Commission on Law
26 Enforcement Standards and Training the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 251 of 2013, for various maintenance,
29 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
30 repair of real property and facilities of the Arkansas Commission on Law
31 Enforcement Standards and Training, in a sum not to exceed.....\$120,000.

32 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for various maintenance,
34 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, operational
35 expenses, upgrade and repair of real property and facilities of the Arkansas
36 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards & Training (ALETA), in a sum not to



1 exceed.....\$500,000.

2 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for major maintenance, renovation,
4 and repair of the ALETA - East Camden North Dormitory, in a sum not to exceed
5\$525,000.

6 (D) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for the replacement of heat and air
8 units, in a sum not to exceed.....\$85,000.

9 (E) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for the purchase of an automatic
11 transfer switch, wiring, and connections for ALETA - East Camden, in a sum
12 not to exceed.....\$20,000.

13 (F) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for the addition, renovation, and
15 replacement of existing buildings for ALETA - East Camden, in a sum not to
16 exceed.....\$210,000.

17 (G) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for the purchase of kitchen and
19 physical fitness equipment, in a sum not to exceed.....\$55,000.

20 (H) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
21 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for the purchase of the MILO
22 Computerized Shooting Simulator Training System, in a sum not to exceed
23\$70,000.

24 (I) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 266 of 2013, for new construction, improvement,
26 and equipment costs for the ALETA - Firing Range - East Camden, in a sum not
27 to exceed.....\$1,600,000.

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29 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
30 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
31 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
32 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
33 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
34 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
35 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
36 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects

1 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
2 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
3 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
4 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

5 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
6 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
7 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
8 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
9 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
10 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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12 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
23 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
31 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
