- 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING
- 13 REQUIREMENTS. The Department shall present the following data to Legislative
- 14 Council quarterly, due by the 15th day of the month following the quarter:
- 15 a) Number and type of environmental permits currently authorized by the
- 16 Department and the Pollution Control and Ecology Commission in each
- 17 environmental permit category;
- 18 b) Total funds collected from permit fees for each permit category and the
- 19 percent increase or decrease in permit fees annually;
- 20 c) Description of each environmental permit application pending in each
- 21 environmental permit category, the number of days each permit has been
- 22 pending, and the reasons for delays in issuing permits for each permit that
- 23 has been pending for more than 45 days;
- 24 d) Number and type of enforcement actions initiated by the Department, the
- 25 geographic location of each violation and the total fines and collections
- 26 from Supplemental Environmental Projects, the percent increase or decrease in
- 27 fines levied annually and
- 28 e) Description of all pending rulemaking activities and justifications
- 29 thereof, including economic impact and environmental benefit analysis.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
- 31 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

- 33 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
- 35 TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
- 36 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may transfer from various

- 1 department funds to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund
- 2 Account, the sum of \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2015 2016 2016-2017, for the
- 3 exclusive purpose of supplementing funding for the appropriation provided in
- 4 Section 3. Appropriation - State Operations. The funds shall be used for
- 5 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of
- 6 Environmental Quality - State Operations. Funds which remain in the Arkansas

- 16 REQUIREMENTS. For the purposes of the fund transfers provided for in Section
- 17 40 - Fund Transfer Provision, the amounts transferred shall not be considered
- 18 as part of any statutory limitation on the use of funds for administration of
- 19 programs of the Department.
- 20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
- 21 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

- 23 SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL
- 25 POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000
- 26 per site from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund, as appropriated in
- 27 Section 20, Item (04) for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts
- 28 of closed disposal sites previously operated as a landfill pursuant to state
- 29 law will be prioritized and authorized by the Commission after addressing
- 30 corrective actions needed to address environmental impacts from permitted
- 31 landfills closed properly. Expenditures exceeding \$2,000,000 per fiscal year
- 32 must be approved by the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission.
- 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 36

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NOW
- 2 HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas
- 3 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non
- 4 hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in
- 5 Section 32, shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Arkansas
- 6 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department
- 7 of Environmental Quality shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible
- 8 for damages to the environment that dictate the use of appropriation
- 9 authorized in Section 32 of this act, as well as, any other funds spent by a
- 10 governmental entity to remediate such non hazardous sites.

- 14 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
- 15 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 16 LANDFILL POST-CLOSURE TRUST FUND.
- 17 (a) The General Assembly finds that:
- 18 (1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts
- 19 within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of
- 20 closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and
- 21 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills,
- 22 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.
- 23 (b) Notwithstanding \S 8-6-1001 et seq. and Acts 2014, No. 1202, \S 41,
- 24 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:
- 25 (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a
- 26 state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to
- 27 complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure
- 28 care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the
- 29 department determines that the regional solid waste management district:
- 30 (A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law;

7 SECTION 45. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17 SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26 <u>SECTION 47. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the

General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

29 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of</u>

30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

31 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm

33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
