5	(b) A school district may establish a written student discipline policy	
6	and exemptions concerning the possession and use by a student of a personal	
7	electronic device:	
8	(1) On school property;	
9	(2) At an after-school activity; or	
10	(3) At a school-related function.	
11	(c) The policy may, without limitation:	
12	(1) Allow or restrict the possession and use of a personal	
13	electronic device;	
14	(2) Allow the use of a personal electronic device in school for	
15	instructional purposes at the discretion of a teacher or administrator;	
16	(3) Limit the times or locations in which a personal electronic	
17	device may be used to make telephone calls, send text messages or emails, or	
18	engage in other forms of communication;	
19	(4) Allow or prohibit the use of any photographic, audio, or	
20	video recording capabilities of a personal electronic device while in school	
21	(5) Exempt the possession or use of a personal electronic device	
22	by a student who is required to use such a device for health or another

24	(6) Exempt the possession or use of a personal electronic device	
25	after normal school hours for extracurricular activities; and
