Subtitle

14 TO PROHIBIT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A
15 SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM ACQUIRING, HOLDING,
16 BUYING, RENTING, OR LEASING REAL PROPERTY
17 LOCATED OUTSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE
18 SCHOOL DISTRICT.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-102(c), concerning body corporate, is
25 amended to read as follows:

26 (c) A school district may acquire and hold real estate located within
27 the boundaries of the school district or another school district with the
28 mutual agreement of both school districts and other classes of property.
29

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-620(6)(E), concerning the powers and
31 duties of school district boards of directors generally, is amended to read
32 as follows:

33 (E) Buying, selling, renting, and leasing real property
34 located within the boundaries of the school district or another school
35 district with the mutual agreement of both school districts and personal
36 property on behalf of the school district;

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-21-108(a), concerning school districts authorized to own and convey real property, is amended to read as follows:

(a) In addition to the authority of school districts under § 6-13-620, a school district board of directors may acquire and hold real estate, tenements, hereditaments, and other real property located within the boundaries of the school district or another school district with the mutual agreement of both school districts necessary for the education of students and the administration of the school district.
