SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Health - Operations for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred twenty-nine (229) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 6. EXTRA HELP - TRAUMA SYSTEM.
