## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE  
10 LANDS AND FOR DISTRIBUTING PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OR  
11 REDEMPTION OF TAX DELINQUENT LAND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
12 ENDING JUNE 30, 2024; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE  
16 LANDS APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2023-2024  
17 FISCAL YEAR.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
24 for the Commissioner of State Lands for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the  
25 following maximum number of regular employees.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Commissioner of State Lands for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Commissioner of State Lands, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Commissioner of State Lands for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DELINQUENT TAX. There is hereby appropriated, to the Commissioner of State Lands, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for operating expenses and for distributing proceeds from the sale or redemption of tax delinquent land as prescribed by Chapter 37 of Title 26 of the Arkansas Code by the Commissioner of State Lands for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following:

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4 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CAPITAL OUTLAY/OPERATING EXPENSES. There is  
5 hereby appropriated, to the Commissioner of State Lands, to be payable from  
6 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for operating expenses and  
7 capital outlay of the Commissioner of State Lands for the fiscal year ending  
8 June 30, 2024, the following:

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14 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - SUBMERGED LANDS. There is hereby  
15 appropriated, to the Commissioner of State Lands, to be payable from cash  
16 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for personal services and  
17 operating expenses for projects involving submerged land by the Commissioner  
18 of State Lands for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following:

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24 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
25 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
27 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
31 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
36 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

1 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 9 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of  
 11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 12 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 13 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm  
 14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 15 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 16 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 17 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
