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2 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 5 Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No. (08) 6 Summer Projects, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item No. 7 (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate staff who work during the summer 8 months on summer projects, and to cover other expenses of summer project 9 The Summer Projects line item may also be used for the annual 10 cost related to the compensation of eligible staff for shift differential pay 11 as well as compensation of employees for performance of duties assigned as 12 referenced in Section 8 of this Act. Such additional compensation shall not 13 be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 15 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

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- SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind may make special allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties in addition to their normal duties:
- 1) Teaching adult education classes, parent training, student tutorial services on weekends or evenings
 - 2) Coaching one or more sports
 - 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours outside of the normal working day
 - 4) Interpretive Services

Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,500 per school term for any one employee during each fiscal year. Such pay shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said position.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{100}$ 2012 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{100}$ 2013.

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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or

- 1 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind
- 2 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other
- 3 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other
- 4 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's
- 5 written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 6 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not
- 7 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary
- 8 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not
- 9 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the
- 10 higher authorized maximum annual salary.

Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by

13 any agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less

14 than three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of

15 Arkansas any sums received by such employee in violation of this section,

16 together with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

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20 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED

22 SERVICES. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the State Treasurer are

23 authorized to establish a joint paying account in the State Treasury, upon

24 direction of the Board of Trustees for the Arkansas School for the Blind and

25 the Arkansas School for the Deaf. The Board may transfer positions, funds

and appropriations to the paying account from either school to serve both

27 schools in the areas of Accounting, Personnel, Inventory, Safety and Health

28 Services.

29 Funding and appropriations for this account will be from transfers from

the fund accounts and appropriations of each agency and shall be divided

31 proportionately from each agency based on student population. Said funds

32 shall be payable from the joint account as if the positions and other

The State Board of Education shall make reasonable 6 rules and regulations to implement the Braille and Large Print Textbooks 7 appropriation and is hereby authorized to negotiate directly with publishers 8 of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for the purchase of such textbooks. The 9 Arkansas School for the Blind (ASB) is authorized to use funds from this 10 account for costs associated with providing Braille Textbooks and Large Print 11 Textbooks to public schools. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 13 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013. 14 15 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular 18 school term, also work during summer months shall be authorized as additional 19 compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each 20 month or part thereof worked. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 35 MASTERS OR BACHELOR TEACHERS ENTERING STATE SERVICE. 36 superintendent's certification to the State Personnel Administrator of prior

service at an educational institution, the salary of teachers entering state service as teachers for the sensory impaired may be adjusted to a rate of pay closest to but not less than the annual salary they would have received from their previous employer, effective upon employment at ASB.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{2012}$ through June 30, $\frac{2011}{2013}$.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER SALARY INCREASE. In the event that an act is enacted in which the public schools receive funds from the General Assembly to raise the salaries of teachers employed in the public school districts, the Arkansas School for the Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind shall be included.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{100}$ 2012 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{100}$ 2013.

SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a) below, the Arkansas School for the Blind is authorized to adjust current or new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school employees.

For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a) below, the Arkansas School for the Blind may implement salary adjustments to maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas Public School Systems only after a plan for determining and implementing those adjustments has been reviewed by the Office of Personnel Management and by the Personnel Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

For purposes of implementing the plan, the Arkansas School for the Blind is authorized special rates of pay up to the maximum of the assigned grade for classifications listed in subsection (a) below.

Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The Arkansas School for the Blind shall, in addition to the funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as provided by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{1}$ 2012 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{1}$ 2013.

SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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5	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
7	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
