8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NORTHWEST
10 TECHNICAL INSTITUTE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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13 AN ACT FOR THE NORTHWEST TECHNICAL
14 INSTITUTE REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Northwest Technical Institute the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 410 of 2017, for transfers of or refund to
26 expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major
27 maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or
28 facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed\$5,383.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 410 of 2017, for Industrial Technology Center
31 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to
32 exceed\$157,283.

33 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 410 of 2017, for transfers of or refund to
35 expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major
36 maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or



1 facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed\$139,483.

2 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 233 of 2017, for constructing and equipping
4 an Allied Health addition to the Collegiate Center on the Springdale campus,
5 in a sum not to exceed\$3,940,394.

6 (E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 233 of 2017, for Allied Health Facility
8 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to
9 exceed\$5,805,432.

10 (F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 233 of 2017, for Industrial Technology Center
12 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to
13 exceed\$2,471,400.

14 (G) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 233 of 2017, for transfers of or refund to
16 expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major
17 maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or
18 facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
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20 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to
21 the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the cash funds as
22 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the Northwest Technical Institute the
23 following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 410 of 2017, for Industrial Technology Center
26 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to
27 exceed\$55,000.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 410 of 2017, for Allied Health Facility
30 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to
31 exceed\$80,000.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (01) of Section 2 of Act 233 of 2017, for Allied Health Facility
34 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishing costs, in a sum not to
35 exceed\$80,000.

36 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (02) of Section 2 of Act 233 of 2017, for Industrial Technology
2 Center construction, parking, equipment, and furnishing costs, in a sum not
3 to exceed\$55,000.
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5 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
6 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
7 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
8 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
9 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
10 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
11 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
12 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
13 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
14 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
15 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
16 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

17 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
19 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
20 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
21 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
22 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
23 otherwise by law.
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25 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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34 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
35 2018.
