9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 EDUCATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION FOR THE  
11 FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
16 EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION  
17 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2014-2015 FISCAL

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 2014-2015  
26 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

9 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
 11 HELP – STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 12 Education - Educational Television Division – State Operations for the ~~2012-~~  
 13 ~~2013~~ 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or  
 14 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 15 appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time  
 16 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 17 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the  
 18 appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific  
 19 projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from  
 20 limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
 22 2014 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015.

24 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 25 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television  
 26 Division, to be payable from the Educational Television Fund Account, for  
 27 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education -  
 28 Educational Television Division - State Operations for the fiscal year ending  
 29 June 30, 2015, the following:

8 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
 10 HELP – CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 11 Education - Educational Television Division - Cash Operations for the ~~2012-~~  
 12 ~~2013~~ 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or  
 13 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 14 appropriated herein for such purposes: forty-six (46) temporary or part-time  
 15 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 16 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the  
 17 appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific  
 18 projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from  
 19 limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
 21 2014 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015.

23 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 24 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television  
 25 Division, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as  
 26 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services  
 27 and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Educational  
 28 Television Division - Cash Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
 29 2015, the following:

9 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - HONORING ARKANSAS' WAR HEROES. There is

10 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television

11 Division, to be payable from the Educational Television Fund Account, for

12 personal services and operating expenses for the "Honoring Arkansas' War

13 Heroes - Documenting Stories of Arkansas' World War II Veterans"

14 documentation project of the Department of Education - Educational Television

15 Division for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

21 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HONORING

23 ARKANSAS' WAR HEROES. The appropriation authorized in this Act for Honoring

24 Arkansas' War Heroes is not intended to be carried forward into the base

25 level for the purposes of budget preparation. Any appropriation request for

26 this purpose shall be considered a new appropriation request, and therefore

27 will be considered a change level budget request.

28 Notwithstanding any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund

29 balances or any law to the contrary, any funds provided to the Educational

30 Television Fund Account for the purpose of funding the Honoring Arkansas' War

31 Heroes Appropriation which remain in the Educational Television Fund Account

32 at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the Educational Television Fund

33 Account and shall continue to be allocated to the Honoring Arkansas' War

34 Heroes Appropriation in the following fiscal year.

36 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
3 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9  
10 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18  
19 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
21 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of  
23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
25 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm  
26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
28 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
