14 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 16 SERVICE. If Arkansas Tech University cancels the current contract for food 17 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees, 18 the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to 19 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided 20 he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and 21 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the 22 Arkansas Legislative Council.

26 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees of Arkansas Tech University may make

29 special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in

30 an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year for any one coach. Further,

31 if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, Arkansas Tech

32 University shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

the exact disposition of those special allowance funds.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 35 2011 2012 through June 30, 2012 2013.

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SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 2 TECH INSTITUTE. The Arkansas Tech Institute (ATI) shall be administered 3 4 under the direction of Arkansas Tech University. Utilizing a 5 multidisciplinary collaboration of professionals, ATI shall explore, develop, 6 implement, and evaluate new and better ways to integrate the teaching, study 7 and performance of business, engineering, emergency management, and computer 8 sciences for academic, economic, and economic development purposes in 9 Arkansas. ATI priorities shall include, but are not limited to, economic development, technology development, and "cyber-park" development. Arkansas 10 11 Tech University shall make annual reports to the Arkansas Legislative Council 12 on all matters of funding, existing programs, and services offered through 13 ATI. 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2011 15 2012 through June 30, 2012 2013. 16 17 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 23 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 24 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 25 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 26 with in disbursement of said funds. 27 28 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

35 36 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

1	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
3	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
8	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
