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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
24 for the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the
25 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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22 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 23 the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the 2014-
 24 2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 25 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 26 herein for such purposes: one hundred (100) temporary or part-time
 27 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 28 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 29 for the appropriate classification.

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31 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 32 appropriated, to the Cossatot Community College of the University of
 33 Arkansas, to be payable from the Cossatot Community College of the University
 34 of Arkansas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 35 Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the fiscal year
 36 ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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15 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
 16 to the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be
 17 payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Cossatot
 18 Community College of the University of Arkansas, for personal services and
 19 operating expenses of the Cossatot Community College of the University of
 20 Arkansas for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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2 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
3 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
8 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
9 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
10 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
11 with in disbursement of said funds.
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13 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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22 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
24 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
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
