Arkansas Code § 17-103-306(c)(1), concerning the 16 qualifications for a licensed master social worker, is amended to read as 17 follows: 18 (c)(l) The board shall issue a license as a Licensed Certified Social 19 Worker to an applicant who qualifies as follows: 20 (A) Has a master's degree in social work from a program 21 accredited by the Council on Social Work Education or the Canadian 22 Association for Social Work Education, or has received before June 17, 1986, 23 a master's degree in a social work program from an accredited educational 24 institution; 25 (B)(i) Has at least twenty-four (24) months of supervised 26 social work experience under a licensed certified social worker. 27 (ii) The supervised social work experience required 28 under subdivision (c)(l)(B)(i) of this section shall include at least four 29 thousand (4,000) hours in a social work position under the supervision of a licensed certified social worker or a social worker whom the board determines 30 31 to have qualifications equivalent to those required of a licensed certified 32 social worker; 33 (C) Has passed an examination approved by the board for 34 this purpose and level of practice; 35 (D) Has applied for a criminal background check and meets 36 the qualifications for issuance of a license under § 17-103-307;

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(E) Has good moral character; (F) Is physically and mentally competent to provide social work services with reasonable skill and safety; (G)(F) Is not affected by a mental or physical disease or condition that would impair the applicant's competency to provide social work services; (H)(G) Has not pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty of a felony listed under § 17-3-102 or criminal offense involving violence, dishonesty, fraud, deceit, breach of client trust, or abuse of the vulnerable; (I) (H) Does not use drugs or alcohol to an extent that the use affects the applicant's professional competency; and (J)(I) Has not engaged in fraud or deceit in making the application.
