11	Public Employees' Retirement System to pay any portion of the benefits

13	$\frac{(d)(1)(e)(1)}{(e)(1)}$ The board may remove by board resolution the benefit		
14	stipend from the base amount of current retirants and option beneficiaries		
15	the board determines that the removal of the benefit stipend from the base		
16	amount is prudent in order to maintain actuarial soundness.		
17	(2) The board may phase in the removal of the benefit stipend		
18	from the base amount of current retirant and option beneficiaries by board		
19	resolution.		
20	(f) The provisions of this section are severable, and if any provision		
21	of this act is declared invalid, then the remaining provisions of this		
22	<u>section shall remain valid.</u>

24	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the operations of the Arkansa		
26	Teacher Retirement System must be able to meet the needs of its members as		
27	anticipated by the General Assembly; that certain provisions of the Arkansas		
28	Teacher Retirement System are in imminent need of revision before the fiscal		
29	year begins on July 1, 2019; and that this act is immediately necessary in		
30	order to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members of the		
31	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
32	exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace		
33	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
