 16 the Secretary of State - Operations for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the
 17 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as

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 33 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 35 REIMBURSEMENT. The Miscellaneous Revolving Fund shall be reimbursed in the
 36 manner provided by law.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
2 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

4 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
6 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
7 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
8 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line
9 item authorized in Operations appropriation to any other line item authorized
10 in Operations appropriation.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
12 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

13
14 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE
16 CAPITOL POLICE. In the event that sufficient revenues, in the judgment of
17 the Secretary of State exist, the Secretary is hereby authorized to make
18 additional salary payments from such funds to those employees who have
19 attained law enforcement certification above the basic certificate level, as
20 defined by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards. It is the
21 intent of this Section that such payment shall be optional, at the discretion
22 of the Secretary, dependent on sufficient revenues and shall not be
23 implemented using funds specifically set aside for other programs within the
24 Department.

25 Employees shall be eligible for all or a portion of additional salary
26 payments scheduled as follows:

31 Payment of such funds may be made monthly, quarterly, semiannually or
32 annually depending upon the availability of revenues and shall be restricted
33 to the following classifications:

- 34 1. Sec. of State Capitol Police Chief
- 35 2. Sec. of State Police Sergeant
- 36 3. Sec. of State Corporal

1 4. Sec. of State Capitol Police Captain

2 Payments made under this Section which are awarded as partial or lump sum
3 payments shall not be considered as salary for purposes of retirement
4 benefits but shall be subject to withholding of all applicable federal and
5 state taxes. Payments made under this Section shall not be construed as
6 exceeding the maximum annual salary of the employee.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
8 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

9
10 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19
20 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28
29 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
31 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
