19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-34-104(a), concerning requirements for
22 providing child passenger restraints, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a) ~~Every driver who transports a child under fifteen (15) years of~~
24 ~~age in a passenger automobile, van, or pickup truck, other than one (1)~~
25 ~~operated for hire, which is registered in this or any other state, shall~~
26 ~~provide while the motor vehicle is in motion and operated on a public road,~~
27 ~~street, or highway of this state~~ While operating a motor vehicle on a public
28 road, street, or highway of this state, a driver who transports a child under
29 fifteen (15) years of age in a passenger automobile, van, or pickup truck,
30 other than one operated for hire, shall provide for the protection of the
31 child by properly placing, maintaining, and securing the child in a child
32 passenger restraint system properly secured to the vehicle and meeting
33 applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards in effect on January 1,
34 1995.
