15	requirements of licensed dispensing opticians.		
16	(b) A licensed dispensing optician shall:		
17	(1) Dispense contact lenses only upon a written prescription		
18	from a licensed optometrist or licensed physician skilled in disease of the		
19	<u>eye;</u>		
20	(2) Advise the intended wearer of the contact lenses at the time		
21	of dispensing to return to the licensed optometrist or licensed physician		
22	skilled in disease of the eye for evaluation and follow-up care;		
23	(3) Not fit a generic type of contact lenses or mode of wear for		
24	contact lenses contrary to the type or mode prescribed; and		
25	(4) Not duplicate contact lenses solely from previously prepared		
26	<u>contact lenses.</u>
