6	(c) This section is a state law within the meaning of subsection (d)
7	of 8 U.S.C. § 1621, as existing on January 1, 2021.
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9	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. Rules implementing this act.
10	(a) All occupational or professional licensing entities shall
11	promulgate rules necessary to implement this act.
12	(b)(1) When adopting the initial rules to implement this act, the
13	final rule shall be filed with the Secretary of State for adoption under §
14	<u>25-15-204(f):</u>
15	(A) On or before January 1, 2022; or
16	(B) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by
17	January 1, 2022, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
18	(2) An occupational or professional licensing entity shall file
19	the proposed rule with the Legislative Council under § 10-3-309(c)
20	sufficiently in advance of January 1, 2022, so that the Legislative Council
21	may consider the rule for approval before January 1, 2022.
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
