14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 9-13-101(a)(1)(A), concerning the award of		
15	custody, is amended to read as follows:		
16	(a)(1)(A)(i) In an action for divorce, the The award of custody of a		
17	child of the marriage shall be made without regard to the sex of a parent but		
18	solely in accordance with the welfare and best interest of the child.		
19	(ii) In determining the best interest of the child,		
20	the court may consider the preferences of the child if the child is of a		
21	sufficient age and mental capacity to reason, regardless of chronological		
22	age.		
23	(iii) In an action for divorce, an <u>An</u> award of joint		
24	custody is favored in Arkansas.		
25			
26	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 9-13-101(a)(3), concerning the award of		
27	custody, is repealed.		
28	(3) For purposes of this section, "grandparent" does not mean a		
29	parent of a putative father of a child.
