21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-18-103(a), concerning trafficking of  
24 persons, is amended to read as follows:

25 (a) A person commits the offense of trafficking of persons if he or  
26 she knowingly:

27 (1) Recruits, harbors, transports, obtains, entices, solicits,  
28 isolates, provides, or maintains a person knowing that the person will be  
29 subjected to involuntary servitude;

30 (2) Benefits financially or benefits by receiving anything of  
31 value from participation in a venture under subdivision (a)(1) of this  
32 section;

33 (3) Subjects a person to involuntary servitude; ~~or~~

34 (4) *Recruits, entices, solicits, isolates, harbors, transports,*  
35 *provides, maintains, or obtains a minor for commercial sexual activity; or*

36 (5) Sells or offers to sell travel services that he or she knows



1 includes an activity prohibited under subdivisions (a)(1)-(4) of this  
2 section.
