1 and the chair and vice chair or cochairs and co-vice chairs of the 2 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee shall be ex officio members of the 3 Legislative Council and shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as other 4 Legislative Council members. 5 (B)(i) If the immediate past Speaker of the House of 6 Representatives is not a member of the House, the current Speaker of the 7 House of Representatives may appoint a member of the House to serve in the 8 stead of the immediate past Speaker of the House of Representatives. 9 (ii) If the immediate past President Pro Tempore of 10 the Senate is not a member of the Senate, the current President Pro Tempore 11 of the Senate may appoint a member of the Senate to serve in the stead of the 12 immediate past President Pro Tempore of the Senate. 13 (iii) If the immediate past House Cochair of the 14 Legislative Council is not a member of the House, the Speaker of the House of 15 Representatives may appoint a member of the House to serve in the stead of 16 the immediate past House cochair. 17 (iv) If the immediate past Senate Cochair of the 18 Legislative Council is not a member of the Senate, the President Pro Tempore 19 of the Senate may appoint a member of the Senate to serve in the stead of the 20 immediate past Senate cochair. 21 (v) If the immediate past House Cochair of the 22 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee is not a member of the House, the 23 Speaker of the House of Representatives may appoint a member of the House to 24 serve in the stead of the immediate past House cochair. 25 (vi) If the immediate past Senate Cochair of the 26 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee is not a member of the Senate, the 27 President Pro Tempore of the Senate may appoint a member of the Senate to 28 serve in the stead of the immediate past Senate cochair. 29 (vii) If the House Cochair of the Legislative Joint 30 Auditing Committee has not been elected, the Speaker of the House of Representatives may appoint a member of the House to serve until the House 31 32 members of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee elect a cochair of the 33 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee. 1 members of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee elect a co-vice chair of 2 the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee; 3 (4)(A) The majority party leader and minority party leader of the House or their designees, and the majority party leader and the minority 4 5 party leader in the Senate or their designees shall be members of the 6 Legislative Council and shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as other 7 Legislative Council members. 8 (B)(i) If the majority party leader or the minority party 9 leader in the House elects to designate a person to serve, that designation shall be subject to confirmation by the Speaker of the House of 10 11 Representatives. 12 (ii) If the majority party leader or the minority 13 party leader in the Senate elects to designate a person to serve, that 14 designation shall be subject to confirmation by the President Pro Tempore of 15 the Senate; and 16 (5) The majority party whip and minority party whip in the 17 Senate or their designees and the majority party whip and the minority party 18 whip in the House or their designees shall be members of the Legislative 19 Council and shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as other Legislative 20 Council members. 21 (b)(1) In order that there may be no vacancies on the Legislative 22 Council at any time, at the time the members are selected to the Legislative 23 Council by the Senate and by the House, there shall also be selected, in the 24 same manner, one (1) first alternate member and one (1) second alternate member for each regular member. 25 26 (2)(A) First alternate members shall also be nonvoting members 27 of the Legislative Council and shall be entitled to per diem and mileage for 28 attending all meetings of the Legislative Council. 29 (B) First alternate members of the Legislative Council 30 shall have a vote in matters before the Legislative Council if the regular member which the first alternate represents is not in attendance. 31 32 (C) First alternate members attending as nonvoting members 33 of the Legislative Council shall receive per diem and mileage to be paid in 34 the same manner and from the same source as regular members of the 35 Legislative Council. 36 (3) Second alternate members of the Legislative Council shall

1 have a vote in matters before the Legislative Council if the regular member 2 and the first alternate member which the second alternate represents are not 3 in attendance. 4 (c) In the event of a tie vote in the congressional caucus to elect 5 members and alternates, the member or alternate shall be elected by the 6 entire membership of the House or Senate, as the case may be. 7 (d)(1) Following the selection by caucus of the regular and alternate 8 Senate members of the Legislative Council from the respective congressional 9 districts, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint from the membership of the Senate his or her first and second alternate members. 10 11 (2) The designation of first and second alternate members by the 12 President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be made prior to adjournment of 13 each regular session of the General Assembly. 14 (3)(A) The selection and designation of first and second 15 alternate members from the membership of the House shall be in accordance 16 with the procedure prescribed by the Rules of the House of Representatives. 17 (B) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the 18 contrary, after January 1, 1999, the selection and designation of first and 19 second alternate members from the membership of the Senate shall be in 20 accordance with the procedure prescribed by the Rules of the Senate. 21 (4) The names of the persons shall be entered upon the journal 22 of the respective houses. 23 (e)(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, 24 tenure of membership and the means of filling vacant positions for Senate 25 Legislative Council members shall be as prescribed by the Rules of the 26 Senate. 27 (2) Tenure of membership and means of filling vacant positions 28 for House Legislative Council members shall be as prescribed by the Rules of 29 the House of Representatives. 30 (f)(l) The cochairs of the Joint Budget Committee shall be ex officio voting members of the Legislative Council. 31 32 (2) The House Chair of the Joint Budget Committee may designate 33 the House Vice Chair of the Joint Budget Committee and other House chairs of Joint Budget Committee subcommittees as ex officio nonvoting members of the 34 Legislative Council, thereby authorizing their attendance at meetings of the 35

18	Gouncil, a $\underline{\mathtt{A}}$ separate vote of House members and Senate members shall be take		
19	on any issue or matter brought before the Legislative Council and approval o		
20	each house shall be required for the action.		
21	(2) The adoption or amendment of the rules of the Legislative		
22	Council shall require approval by a separate vote of Senate Legislative		
23	Council members and House Legislative Council members.
