The report shall be submitted in an electronic media 13 format approved by the Legislative Auditor. The letter shall contain at least 14 the following information: 15 (1) The date of the letter of completion; 16 (2) The name of the entity engaging the accountants; 17 (3) The time period covered by the audit report or agreed-upon 18 procedures report; 19 (4) The date of the audit report or agreed-upon procedures 20 report; 21 (5) The name, title, address, and telephone number of the 22 entity's contact person; 23 (6) The name, title, address, and telephone number of the 24 accountant performing the audit or the agreed-upon procedures; and 25 (7) The signature of the accountant. 26 (b) Upon request by the Legislative Auditor, the accountant shall 27 furnish a copy of the audit report or report of agreed-upon procedures to the 28 Division of Legislative Audit within thirty (30) days of the date of the 29 request. 30 31 32 33 34 35 36

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
