28	28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-9-715(a), co	oncerning attorney fees for
29	29 legal services, is amended to read as follows:	
30	30 (a)(1)(A) Fees for legal services rendered	d in respect of a claim shall
31	31 not be valid unless approved by the Workers' Comp	pensation Commission.
32	32 (B) Attorney's fees shall be	twenty-five percent (25%) of
33	33 compensation for indemnity benefits payable to the	ne injured employee or
34	34 dependents of a deceased employee. Attorney's fee	es shall not be awarded on
35	35 medical benefits or services except as provided :	in subdivision (a)(4) of this
36	36 section.	

- 1 (2)(A) Whenever the commission finds that a claim against the
 2 Treasurer of State, as custodian of the Second Injury Trust Fund or as
 3 custodian of the Death and Permanent Total Disability Trust Fund, has been
 4 controverted, in whole or in part, the commission shall direct that fees for
 5 legal services be paid from the fund, in addition to compensation awarded,
 6 and the fees shall be allowed only on the amount of compensation controverted
 7 and awarded from the fund.
- 8 (B)(i) In all other cases whenever the commission finds 9 that a claim has been controverted, in whole or in part, the commission shall 10 direct that fees for legal services be paid to the attorney for the claimant 11 as follows: One-half (½) by the employer or carrier in addition to 12 compensation awarded; and one-half (½) by the injured employee or dependents 13 of a deceased employee out of compensation payable to them.
- 14 (ii) The fees shall be allowed only on the amount of 15 compensation for indemnity benefits controverted and awarded.

- (iii) However, the commission shall not find that a claim has been controverted if the claimant or his or her representative has withheld from the respondent during the period of time allotted for the respondent to determine its position any medical information in his or her possession which substantiates the claim.
- (C)(i) Whenever the commission finds that a claim has not been controverted but further finds that bona fide legal services have been rendered in respect to the claim, then the commission shall direct the payment of the fees by the injured employee or dependents of a deceased employee out of the compensation awarded.
- (ii) In determining the amount of fees when a claim is not controverted, the commission shall use its discretion in awarding an attorney's fee not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) and in so doing shall take into consideration the nature, length, and complexity of the services performed and the benefits resulting to the compensation beneficiaries.
- 31 (3) In any case where attorney's fees are allowed by the
 32 commission, the limitations expressed in the first sentence herein shall
 33 apply.
 - (4) Medical providers may voluntarily contract with the attorney for the claimant to recover disputed bills, and the attorney may charge a reasonable fee to the medical provider as a cost of collection.

6	payable in connection with disability or death due to injuries occurring on	
7	or after July 1, 2001 the effective date of this act.
