## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS  
9 TRANSFERS FOR PERSONAL SERVICES - PAYPLAN EXTRA HELP  
10 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -  
11 DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN  
12 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 251 OF  
13 2016; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
17 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER -  
18 PERSONAL SERVICES - PAYPLAN EXTRA HELP  
19 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - MISCELLANEOUS TRANSFERS - PERSONAL SERVICES  
26 - PAYPLAN EXTRA HELP. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
27 Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the  
28 Miscellaneous State Treasury Funds, for providing constitutional officers and  
29 various state agencies with supplemental appropriations by the Department of  
30 Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer which shall be supplemental  
31 and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 251 of 2016,

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 3 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
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13 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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22 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 23 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
 24 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to  
 25 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and  
 26 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential  
 27 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the  
 28 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -  
 29 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the  
 30 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
 31 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
 32 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
 33 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
 34 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

35 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall  
 36 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the

1 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the  
2 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house  
3 overrides the veto.
