5 (b) This section shall apply to all companies and corporations doing 6 business in this state and to all servants and employees thereof. Any 7 servants or employees who shall hereafter be discharged or refused further 8 employment may request or demand the payment of any wages due and, if not 9 paid within seven (7) days from discharge or refusal to longer employ, then 10 the penalties provided in subdivision (a)(2) of this section for railway 11 employees shall attach.

12 (e)(b) Any servant or employee whose employment is for a definite 13 period of time and who is discharged without cause before the expiration of 14 that time may, in addition to the penalties prescribed by this section, have 15 an action against any employer for any damages he or she may have sustained 16 by reason of the wrongful discharge, and the action may be joined with an 17 action for unpaid wages and penalty.

18 (d)(c) No A servant or employee who secretes or absents himself or 19 <u>herself</u> to avoid payment to him or her, or refuses to receive payment when 20 fully tendered, shall <u>not</u> be entitled to any benefit under this section for 21 the time as he or she so avoids payment.

23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, is amended 24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

<u>11-4-406. Dispute over amount of wages.</u>

26 (a)(1)(A) In a dispute over the amount of wages due to an employee,
 27 an employer shall pay, without condition, all wages or parts of wages that
 28 the employer concedes to be due to the employee.

29 (B) If at the time of discharge, an employee possesses 30 property belonging to the employer, subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this section 31 does not apply until the employee returns the property to the employer. 32 (2) After a payment under subdivision (a)(1) of this section,

33 <u>the employee retains all remedies to which he or she might otherwise be</u> 34 entitled regarding any balance claimed.

35 (b)(1) The acceptance by an employee of a payment under this section 36 does not constitute a release of the employee's claim to the balance of his
