1 (iii) Situated in the plain view of a poll worker. 2 (C) If a person is not a poll worker and is not casting a 3 ballot, he or she shall not be within six feet (6') of the voting booths, 4 unless: 5 (i) The person is authorized by an election judge; 6 and 7 (ii)The person's presence is necessary to keep 8 order or enforce the law. 9 (3) A person may not enter a polling place site on election day 10 during voting hours unless the person is: 11 (A) An election official; 12 (B) An authorized poll watcher; 13 (C) A voter present to cast his or her ballot; 14 (D) A person in the care of a voter if the person: 15 (i) Does not disrupt or interfere with the normal 16 voting procedures; and 17 (ii) Is not eligible to vote in that election; 18 (E) A person lawfully assisting the voter; 19 (F) A law enforcement officer or emergency service 20 personnel who are acting in the line of duty; 21 (G) A monitor authorized by the State Board of Election 22 Commissioners or observer authorized by a federal agency with the authority 23 to place the observer at the polling place site; 24 (H)(i) A person with business in the polling place site 25 that is not connected to the election. 26 (ii) A person with business in the polling place 27 site that is not connected to the election shall remain outside of the voter 28 processing area or voting room except to pass through or by the voter 29 processing area or voting room without speaking to a voter or an election 30 official and with the purpose to conduct his or her business; 31 (I) A person that the county clerk or the county board of 32 election commissioners has authorized to assist in conducting the election; 33 (J) A person authorized by the State Board of Election 34 Commissioners or the county board of election commissioners; and 35 (K) the county clerk. 36 (b)(1) A voter shall inform the poll workers at the time that the

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1 voter presents himself or herself to vote that he or she is unable to mark or 2 cast the ballot without help and needs assistance in casting or marking his 3 or her ballot. 4 (2) The voter shall be directed to a voting machine equipped for 5 use by persons with disabilities by which he or she may elect to cast his or 6 her ballot without assistance, or the voter may request assistance with 7 either the paper ballot or the voting machine, depending on the voting system 8 in use for the election, by: 9 (A) Two (2) poll workers; or 10 (B) A person named by the voter. 11 (3) If the voter is assisted by two (2) poll workers, one (1) of 12 the poll workers shall observe the voting process and one (1) may assist the 13 voter in marking and casting the ballot according to the wishes of the voter 14 without comment or interpretation. 15 (4)(A)(i) If the voter is assisted by one (1) person named by 16 the voter, he or she may assist the voter in marking and casting the ballot 17 according to the wishes of the voter without any comment or interpretation. 18 (ii) If an election official witnesses the person assisting the voter comment or interpret in violation of subdivision 19 20 (b)(4)(A)(i) of this section: 21 (a) The election official may cause the person 22 assisting the voter to be removed from the polling site; and 23 (b) If the voter requests additional assistance in marking and casting his or her ballot, it may be provided by 24 25 two (2) election officials trained to do so. 26 (B) No person other than the following shall assist more 27 than six (6) voters in marking and casting a ballot at an election: 28 (i) A poll worker; (ii) The county clerk during early voting; or 29 (iii) A deputy county clerk during early voting. 30 31 (C) If the person whose assistance has been requested by 32 the voter is a candidate on the ballot: 33 (i) The candidate shall not assist more than six (6) 34 voters in the election; and 35 (ii) The candidate may only assist a voter who is

related to the candidate within the second degree of consanguinity.

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1	(5) It shall be the duty of the poll workers at the polling site		
2	to make and maintain a list of the names and addresses of all persons		
3	assisting voters.		
4	(c) Any voter who because of physical, sensory, or other disability		
5	who presents himself or herself for voting and who then informs a poll worker		
6	at the polling site that he or she is unable to stand in line for extended		
7	periods of time shall be entitled to and assisted by a poll worker to advance		
8	to the head of any line of voters then waiting in line to vote at the polling		
9	site.		
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11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-403(d)(4), concerning absentee ballots		
12	submitted by administrators, is amended to read as follows:		
13	(4) Before obtaining an absentee ballot, an administrator shall		
14	submit to the county clerk an affidavit, signed and dated by the		
15	administrator, stating:		
16	(A) That he or she is the administrative head of a long-		
17	term care or residential care facility licensed by the state;		
18	(B) The name and address of the facility;		
19	(C) That he or she has been authorized by the voters who		
20	reside in his or her facility to obtain from the county clerk and return to		
21	the county clerk absentee ballots on their behalf; and		
22	(D) That each of the voters for whom the administrator		
23	seeks to obtain an absentee ballot has named the administrator on his or her		
24	application <u>; and</u>		
25	(E) That the administrator understands that Arkansas law		
26	requires that the administrator shall assist the voter by marking or casting		
27	a ballot on behalf of the voter without any comment or interpretation.
