- 13 investigation of all suspected adult maltreatment or long-term care facility
- 14 resident maltreatment in accordance with this subchapter.
- 15 (b)(1) The investigation shall be completed and an investigative
- 16 determination entered within sixty (60) days.
- 17 (2) The investigation shall be conducted by an examination and
- 18 review of the allegations and any other information concerning suspected
- 19 adult maltreatment or long-term care facility resident maltreatment received
- 20 by or collected by the department from any source.
- 21 (2)(3) The investigation and written investigative report shall
- 22 include:
- 23 (A) The nature, extent, and cause of the maltreatment
- 24 adult maltreatment or long-term care facility resident maltreatment;
- 25 (B) The identity of the person responsible;
- 26 (C) The names and conditions of other adults in the home,

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6	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that currently each finding of		
8	abuse or neglect by the Department of Human Services is subject to challeng		
9	unless the department sends a person to conduct an investigation in person;		
10	that the department's review and adoption of the maltreatment investigation		
11	record submitted by a nursing home, a practice in place for decades, was		
12	determined to be out of compliance; and that this act is immediately		
13	necessary because this act would correct that situation. Therefore, an		
14	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for		
15	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
16	effective on:		
17	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
18	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
19	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
20	bill; or		
21	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
22	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
