2	(2)(A) The next fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred
3	fifty (150) freshman enrollment positions shall be allocated to the state at
4	large and assigned to applicants who are legal residents of any place within
5	Arkansas.
6	(B) However, in allocating the fifteen percent (15%) to
7	the state at large, the board may allocate not to exceed one-third (1/3) of
8	the fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred fifty (150) freshman
9	enrollment positions to applicants who do not actually reside in the state
10	but who were born and reared and attended public schools in Arkansas and who
11	in addition thereto shall meet two (2) or more of the following criteria:
12	(i) Applicant is a registered voter in Arkansas;
13	(ii) Applicant holds a current valid Arkansas
14	driver's license;
15	(iii) Applicant or parents of applicant are Arkansas
16	<del>taxpayers;</del>
17	(iv) Parent of applicant resides in or is employed
18	in Arkansas; and
19	(v) Applicant meets other related criteria as may be
20	prescribed by the board.
21	(3) The remaining fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred
22	fifty (150) freshman enrollment positions may be assigned either to legal
23	residents or to nonresidents, however, any qualified legal resident shall
24	have a preference in securing an assignment to a position when compared to a
25	nonresident, and the total number of nonresidents assigned positions shall
26	not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred fifty (150)
27	freshman enrollment positions assigned for any school year.
28	(4) The board may provide for an alteration in the percentages
29	set forth in this subsection only if the adherence to these percentages would
30	endanger the accredited rating of the University of Arkansas College of
31	Medicine as determined by the Standards of the Association of American
32	Medical Colleges.
