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23	SECTION 1. APP	ROPRIATION - FIRE RATING REDUCTION PLAN	GRANTS. There is
24	hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, to		
25	be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for Fire Rating		
26	Reduction Plan grants by the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management for		
27	the fiscal year endin	ng June 30, 2018, the sum of	\$1,000,000.

29	SECTION 2. SPE	CIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED I	NTO THE ARKANSAS
30	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.		
31	FUNDING TRANSFER. Once the Director of the Arkansas Department of Emergency		
32	Management determines Pilot Programs for the Fire Rate Reduction Plan have		
33	been implemented and are effective, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State		
34	shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the		
35	Auditor of the State the sum of \$1,000,000 (one million dollars) from the		
36	General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund

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4 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 14 15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 22

23 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 25 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 29 30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 31 32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017. 34 35

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
