19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-17-108 is amended to read as follows:*

22 *16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various*
23 *district courts. [Effective January 1, 2012.]*

24 *(a) Unless otherwise provided by law, the salaries of the judges and*
25 *other personnel of the various district courts shall be established as*
26 *follows:*

27 *(1) The Arkansas County District Court – Northern District Judge*
28 *shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars*
29 *(\$35,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the district court*
30 *clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand eight*
31 *hundred thirty-four dollars and ninety-two cents (\$13,834.92) nor more than*
32 *thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000), and the deputy court clerk shall*
33 *receive an annual salary of not less than eleven thousand four hundred*
34 *seventy-five dollars (\$11,475) nor more than twenty-eight thousand dollars*
35 *(\$28,000). The salaries shall be as determined by the governing body of the*
36 *City of Stuttgart and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid one-half (½)*



1 by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the county;

2 (2) The Arkansas County District Court – Southern District Judge
3 shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand dollars
4 (\$13,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the district court
5 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand five
6 hundred dollars (\$12,500) nor more than thirty-four thousand dollars
7 (\$34,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
8 than ten thousand five hundred dollars (\$10,500) nor more than twenty-eight
9 thousand dollars (\$28,000). The salaries shall be determined by the governing
10 body of the City of DeWitt and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid one-
11 half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the county;

12 (3) The Ashley County District Court – Crossett Department Judge
13 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars
14 (\$20,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000), and the
15 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen
16 thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
17 (\$25,000). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range prescribed in
18 this subdivision (a)(3), as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum Court and
19 the governing body of the City of Crossett;

20 (4) The Ashley County District Court – Hamburg Department Judge
21 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars
22 (\$20,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000), and the
23 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen
24 thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
25 (\$25,000). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range prescribed in
26 this subdivision (a)(4), as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum Court and
27 the governing body of the City of Hamburg;

28 (5) The Baxter County District Court Clerk shall receive
29 compensation in an amount as may be provided by the City of Mountain Home and
30 the Baxter County Quorum Court. The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the
31 City of Mountain Home and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Baxter County;

32 (6) The Bradley County District Court Judge shall receive an
33 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
34 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as established by the Bradley
35 County Quorum Court and approved by the governing body of the City of Warren;

36 (7)(A) The Calhoun County District Court ~~Judge shall receive an~~

1 ~~annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more~~
2 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) and the clerk Clerk of the court shall~~
3 *receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000)*
4 *nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by*
5 *the Hampton City Council and the Calhoun County Quorum Court.*

6 (B) ~~The salaries~~ salary shall be paid by the City of
7 Hampton and Calhoun County in equal monthly installments;

8 (8) *The Camden District Court Judge shall receive an annual*
9 *salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty*
10 *thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita*
11 *County;*

12 (9) *The Carroll County District Court – Eastern District Judge*
13 *shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars*
14 *(\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000);*

15 (10) *The Carroll County District Court – Western District Judge*
16 *shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars*
17 *(\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000);*

18 (11)(A) *The Chicot County District Court – Dermott Department*
19 *Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand*
20 *dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000).*

21 (B)(i) *The district court clerk shall receive an annual*
22 *salary of not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than*
23 *twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).*

24 (ii) *However, the district court clerk's position*
25 ~~shall~~ may be a full-time or part-time position.

26 (C) *The salaries shall be in an amount within the range*
27 *prescribed in this subdivision (a)(11) as agreed upon by the Chicot County*
28 *Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Dermott.*

29 (D) *The salary of the district court judge and the salary*
30 *of the district court clerk shall be paid as follows:*

31 (i) *Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of*
32 *Dermott; and*

33 (ii) *Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot*
34 *County;*

35 (12)(A) *The Chicot County District Court – Eudora Department*
36 *Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand*

1 dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000), and
2 the district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than
3 fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty thousand dollars
4 (\$20,000).

5 (B) The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
6 prescribed in subdivision (a)(12)(A) of this section as agreed upon by the
7 Chicot County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Eudora.

8 (C) The salary of the district judge and the salary of the
9 district court clerk shall be paid as follows:

10 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
11 Eudora; and

12 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
13 County;

14 (13)(A) The Chicot County District Court – Lake Village
15 Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen
16 thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars
17 (\$26,000), and the district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not
18 less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty thousand
19 dollars (\$20,000). If authorized by the governing body of the City of Lake
20 Village and the Chicot County Quorum Court, the district court judge shall be
21 authorized to employ a full-time or part-time deputy district court clerk at
22 an annual salary of not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor more
23 than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000). The salaries shall be in an amount
24 within the range prescribed in this subdivision (a)(13)(A), as agreed upon by
25 the Chicot County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Lake
26 Village.

27 (B) The salary of the district court judge and the salary
28 of the district court clerk shall be paid as follows:

29 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
30 Lake Village; and

31 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
32 County;

33 (14) ~~The Clark County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
34 ~~annual salary of not less than fifty-three thousand five hundred dollars~~
35 ~~(\$53,500) nor more than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000), and the Clark~~
36 ~~County District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than~~

1 twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand
2 dollars (\$38,000), ~~such salaries~~ to be established annually by the Clark
3 County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum Court, the
4 Clark County District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy district court
5 clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County Quorum Court;

6 (15)(A) The Clay County District Court Judge shall receive an
7 annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor more
8 than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid, as well as other current
9 benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

10 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
11 by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at
12 eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%),
13 and thirteen percent (13%), respectively, to the county treasury.

14 (C) The clerks of the respective district courts shall
15 receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars
16 (\$4,500) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), to be paid, as
17 well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

18 (D) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
19 by the respective cities;

20 (16) ~~The Cleveland County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
21 ~~annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000) nor more~~
22 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the district court clerk Clerk~~
23 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars
24 (\$12,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be
25 determined by the Rison City Council and the Cleveland County Quorum Court;

26 (17) The Columbia County District Court Judge shall receive an
27 annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor
28 more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). Any salaries paid over the
29 minimum salaries set in this subdivision (a)(17) shall be paid only upon the
30 approval of the governing bodies of the City of Magnolia and Columbia County;

31 (18) The Conway County District Court Judge shall receive an
32 annual salary of not less than thirty-two thousand five hundred dollars
33 (\$32,500) nor more than ~~thirty-eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$38,500)~~
34 forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000). However, the salary may be increased
35 by such an amount as may be agreed to by the Conway County Quorum Court and
36 the governing body of the City of Morrilton by ordinances adopted by their

1 *respective bodies;*

2 ~~(19)(A) The Craighead County District Court Judge shall be a~~
 3 ~~full time district judge and shall receive as compensation for services an~~
 4 ~~annual salary of not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) nor~~
 5 ~~more than one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000), as determined by~~
 6 ~~the Craighead County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of~~
 7 ~~Jonesboro, to be paid in equal monthly installments. The amount of the salary~~
 8 ~~shall be appropriated by ordinance adopted by the Craighead County Quorum~~
 9 ~~Court. The amount of the salary and necessary expenses appropriated for the~~
 10 ~~court shall be apportioned among and paid to the county from the respective~~
 11 ~~cities of the first class and cities of the second class, incorporated towns,~~

 18 ~~maintain dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of the county~~
 19 ~~seats of Craighead County and may establish dockets and hold court in other~~
 20 ~~cities and towns in Craighead County, as deemed necessary by ordinance~~
 21 ~~adopted by the Craighead County Quorum Court.~~

22 (B) Necessary expenses appropriated for the Craighead
 23 County District Court shall be apportioned among and paid to the county from
 24 the respective cities of the first class and cities of the second class,
 25 incorporated towns, and the government of Craighead County as a prorated
 26 amount based on the number of cases filed from each of the towns and cities
 27 and the county during the preceding calendar year;

28 ~~(20) The Crawford County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
 29 ~~annual salary of not less than eighty-two thousand dollars (\$82,000) nor more~~
 30 ~~than one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000);~~

31 ~~(21)(20) The Cross County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
 32 ~~annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) nor~~
 33 ~~more than forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000). This salary and the salaries~~
 34 ~~of all court employees shall be as determined by the governing body of the~~
 35 ~~City of Wynne;~~

36 ~~(22)(21) The Dallas County District Court Judge shall receive an~~

1 ~~annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more~~
2 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and each clerk Clerks of the court~~
3 shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars
4 (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), as may be
5 determined by the Fordyce City Council and the Dallas County Quorum Court,
6 and the salaries shall be paid by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in
7 equal monthly installments;

8 ~~(23)~~(22) The Desha County District Court – Dumas Department
9 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand
10 five hundred dollars (\$27,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
11 (\$45,000). The clerk of the district court shall receive an annual salary of
12 not less than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than thirty
13 thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the deputy district clerk shall receive an
14 annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand five hundred dollars
15 (\$14,500) nor more than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000). The salaries
16 shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the Desha County Quorum Court and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
17 by the City of Dumas and shall be determined by the Desha County Quorum Court
18 and the governing body of the City of Dumas;

19 ~~(24)~~(23) The Desha County District Court – McGehee Department
20 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand
21 five hundred dollars (\$27,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
22 (\$45,000). The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the Desha County Quorum
23 Court and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of McGehee and shall be determined by the
24 Desha County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of McGehee. The
25 district court clerk shall be employed and paid by the City of McGehee at
26 such a salary as the governing body of the City of McGehee shall determine;

27 ~~(25)~~(24) The Drew County District Court Judge shall receive an
28 annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more
29 than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
30 by the City of Monticello and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Drew County in the amount as
31 may be agreed to by the Drew County Quorum Court and the governing body of
32 the City of Monticello;

33 ~~(26)~~(25) The East Camden District Court Judge shall receive an
34 annual salary of not less than three thousand eight hundred fifty-nine
35 dollars (\$3,859) nor more than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000), to be
36 paid by the City of East Camden;

1 ~~(27)~~(26) The Elkins District Court Judge shall receive an annual
2 salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than
3 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000). The annual salary for each clerk of
4 the district court shall be not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor
5 more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000);

6 ~~(28)~~ The Faulkner County District Court Judge shall receive an
7 annual salary of not less than seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) nor more
8 than one hundred twelve thousand dollars (\$112,000);

9 ~~(29)~~(27) The Fayetteville District Court Judge shall receive an
10 annual salary of not less than eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) nor more
11 than one hundred ~~thirty-five~~ forty-five thousand dollars ~~(\$135,000)~~
12 (\$145,000);

13 ~~(30)~~(28) The Franklin County District Court – Charleston
14 District Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand
15 dollars (\$10,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The
16 salaries and costs may be set and the payment may be apportioned by agreement
17 between the governing body of the City of Charleston and the Franklin County
18 Quorum Court;

19 ~~(31)~~(29) The Franklin County District Court – Ozark District
20 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand six
21 hundred dollars (\$22,600) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars
22 (\$35,000). The salary and costs may be set and the payment thereof may be
23 apportioned by agreement between the governing body of the City of Ozark and
24 the Franklin County Quorum Court;

25 ~~(32)~~(30) (A) The Fulton County District Court Judge shall receive
26 an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor
27 more than thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000). The annual salary of the
28 Fulton County District Court Clerk shall be not less than fifteen thousand
29 three hundred dollars (\$15,300) nor more than twenty-two thousand dollars
30 (\$22,000).

31 (B) The expense of salaries, along with all other
32 necessary and customary expenses of the court, shall be shared by Fulton
33 County, the City of Salem, and the City of Mammoth Spring, based on a
34 percentage of the actual number of cases handled through the court for each
35 governmental entity. The percentage shall be determined annually by dividing
36 the total number of cases handled by the district court into the number of

1 cases handled annually for each of the aforementioned governmental entities.
2 On January 1 of each year, each share shall be estimated based on the number
3 of cases handled by the district court for each of the respective
4 governmental entities for the preceding year. However, on December 31 of each
5 year, each share shall be adjusted to reflect the actual percentage for each
6 governmental entity for that year based on the actual case load.

7 (C) The salaries and expenses shall be paid in equal
8 monthly installments by Fulton County, and the City of Salem and the City of
9 Mammoth Spring shall reimburse the county on a monthly basis for their
10 respective shares of salaries and expenses;

11 ~~(33)~~(31) The Garland County District Court Judges, Departments 1
12 and 2, shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty-five thousand
13 dollars (\$65,000) nor more than eighty-six thousand dollars (\$86,000), and
14 the Garland County District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not
15 less than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000) nor more than fifty-two
16 thousand dollars (\$52,000). The salaries shall be determined by the governing
17 body of the City of Hot Springs and the Garland County Quorum Court;

18 ~~(34)(A)~~(32)(A) The Grant County District Court Judge shall
19 receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor
20 more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), as approved by the Grant County
21 Quorum Court.

22 (B) The Grant County District Court Clerk shall receive an
23 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more
24 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as approved by the Grant County
25 Quorum Court.

26 (C) The district court judge's and district court clerk's
27 salary shall be paid as follows:

28 (i) Twenty-seven percent (27%) to be paid by the
29 City of Sheridan; and

30 (ii) Seventy-three percent (73%) to be paid by Grant
31 County;

32 ~~(35)~~(33) The Greene County District Court – Paragould District
33 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand eight
34 hundred fifty-six dollars (\$19,856) nor more than forty thousand dollars
35 (\$40,000), the chief deputy district court clerk shall receive an annual
36 salary of not less than sixteen thousand six hundred twenty-four dollars

1 (\$16,624) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the
2 deputy district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than
3 thirteen thousand three hundred fourteen dollars (\$13,314) nor more than
4 thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000). The salaries shall be determined by
5 the Greene County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of
6 Paragould and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments;

7 ~~(36)~~(34) The Hempstead County District Court Judge shall receive
8 an annual salary of not less than thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars
9 ~~(\$37,500)~~, beginning January 1996, nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
10 ~~(\$45,000)~~, and the ~~district court~~ Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not
11 less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor more than thirty
12 thousand dollars (\$30,000). The amount of the ~~salaries~~ salary shall be
13 determined by agreement between the governing body of the City of Hope and
14 the Hempstead County Quorum Court;

15 ~~(37)~~(35) The Hot Spring County District Court Judge shall
16 receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
17 (\$35,000) nor more than ~~fifty-nine~~ sixty-nine thousand five hundred dollars
18 ~~(\$59,500)~~ (\$69,500), as prescribed by the governing body of the City of
19 Malvern and the Hot Spring County Quorum Court, and provided further, that
20 the first seventeen thousand five hundred dollars (\$17,500) shall be paid
21 fifty percent (50%) by the city and fifty percent (50%) by the county, and
22 that portion of the annual salary in excess of seventeen thousand five
23 hundred dollars (\$17,500) shall be paid by the city and county in the same

35 dollars (\$19,000), unless provided for otherwise by ordinance of the Howard
36 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Nashville. The

4 annual salary of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor
5 more than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000), and the district court
6 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand four
7 hundred dollars (\$7,400) nor more than twenty-eight thousand dollars
8 (\$28,000). However, the salaries shall be subject to the approval of the
9 Melbourne City Council and the IZARD County Quorum Court;

10 ~~(40)~~(38) The Jackson County District Court Judge shall receive
11 an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor
12 more than fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000). The salary of the district
13 court judge shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Newport and one-half
14 ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Jackson County;

15 ~~(41)~~(39) The Jacksonville District Court Clerk shall receive an
16 annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand nine hundred thirty-
17 seven dollars (\$33,937) nor more than thirty-six thousand nine hundred
18 dollars (\$36,900);

19 ~~(42)~~(40) The Jasper District Court Judge shall receive an annual
20 salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than
21 twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500), and the district court
22 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand
