4	(3) The requirements of this section do not apply to:		
5	(A) A pregnant woman; or		
6	(B) An individual who objects on medical, religious, or		
7	philosophical grounds and provides documentation.		
8	(c)(1) All food service establishments shall maintain records of the		
9	immunization or vaccination and appropriate boosters for each employee.		
10	(2) The records shall be made available to the Department of		
11	Health or the investigators of the department upon request.		
12	(d)(l) An individual or food service establishment that violates this		
13	section is subject to a fine of no less than fifty dollars (\$50) but not to		
14	<u>exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250).</u>		
15	(2) Each day of a violation after notification constitutes a		
16	separate offense.		
17	(3) Failure to comply with this section may result in civil and		
18	administrative penalties or sanctions, including without limitation		
19	suspension or revocation of a license.		
20	(e) This section does not limit the ability of the State of Arkansas		
21	to take any action necessary to prevent or remedy any violation or protect		
22	the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the state.		
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
