2	for personal services as a classroom teacher, including without limitation		
3	bonuses.		
4	(b) In computing net income for the purposes of this chapter, a		
5	classroom teacher is allowed a deduction, in addition to all other deduction		
6	allowed by law, to be calculated as follows:		
7	(1) For the 2021 tax year, a classroom teacher may deduct the		
8	first twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500) of wages from the		
9	<pre>classroom teacher's net income;</pre>		
10	(2) For the 2022 tax year, a classroom teacher may deduct the		
11	first twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) of wages from the classroom		
12	teacher's net income;		
13	(3) For the 2023 tax year, a classroom teacher may deduct the		
14	first thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$37,500) of wages from the		
15	classroom teacher's net income; and		
16	(4) For tax years beginning on and after January 1, 2024, a		
17	classroom teacher may deduct the first fifty thousand (\$50,000) of wages from		
18	the classroom teacher's net income.		
19	(c)(1) A classroom teacher who leaves the employment of one school		
20	district or private school to become employed in a different school district		
21	or private school shall not claim the deduction under subsection (b) of this		
22	section for both the tax year in which the change in employment occurred and		
23	the next tax year.		
24	(2) Subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall not apply to a		
25	classroom teacher in the first year of full-time, licensed teaching.		
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27	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this act is effective for tax		
28	years beginning on or after January 1, 2021.		
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
