32	required to pay the contractor until the contractor:

8	$\frac{1}{2}$ The liability imposed by § 22-9-401 on any bond furnished by a
9	public works contractor shall be deemed an integral part of the bond, whether
10	or not the liability is explicitly set out or assumed therein.
11	(b)(1) No action shall be brought on a bond after one (1) year from
12	the date final payment is made on the contract, nor shall an action be
13	brought outside the State of Arkansas.
14	(2) However, with respect to public works contracts where final
15	approval for payment is given by the Building Authority Division or by an
16	institution of higher education exempt from construction review and approval
17	by the division, all persons, firms, associations, and corporations having
18	valid claims against the bond may bring an action on the bond against the
19	corporate surety, provided that no action shall be brought on the bond after
20	twelve (12) months from the date on which the division or the public
21	institution of higher education approves final payment on the state contract,
22	nor shall any action be brought outside the State of Arkansas in accordance
23	with § 18-44-503.
