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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-15-304(a)(1), concerning application for
3	a temporary special certificate for a person with a disability, is amended to
4	read as follows:
5	(a)(1) A person with a disability, which, as determined by a licensed
6	physician, is temporary in nature as opposed to permanent, may apply to the
7	Office of Motor Vehicle for a temporary person-with-a-disability special
8	certificate, which may include a temporary van-accessible parking decal, and,
9	upon request, one (1) additional temporary special certificate, which may
10	include an additional van-accessible parking decal.
11	
12	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-15-305(b)(1) and (2), concerning parking
13	in an area designated for exclusive use by a person with a disability and the
14	amount of the fine upon conviction for a violation, are amended to read as
15	follows:
16	(b)(1) $\frac{Any}{A}$ Motor vehicle found to be parked in an area designated
17	for the exclusive use of $\frac{1}{2}$ person with a disability, including the access
18	aisle, <del>as provided in this subchapter, on which is not displayed a</del> <u>may be</u>
19	impounded by a law enforcement agency if the motor vehicle:
20	(A) Does not display a special license plate, a special
21	certificate, van-accessible parking decal, or an similar official designation
22	of another state as authorized in this subchapter; or
23	(B) which is found to be parked in an area designated for the
24	exclusive use of any person with a disability, if Displays a special license
25	plate, special certificate, van-accessible parking decal or similar official
26	designation of another state authorized in this subchapter but is operated by
27	a person who is not <u>:</u>
28	(i) $\frac{1}{2}$ A person with a disability who is authorized
29	to park in the designated area; or

12	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-15-305(c), concerning the use and
13	distribution of fines collected in district court under this section, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	(c)(1) Thirty percent (30%) Fifty percent (50%) of all fines collected
16	under this section in district court or city court shall be for the purpose
17	of funding activities of the Governor's Commission on People with
18	Disabilities and shall be collected and remitted by the tenth day of each
19	month to the Administration of Justice Funds Section of the Office of
20	Administrative Services of the Department of Finance and Administration, on a
21	form provided by the section, for deposit into a special fund established and
22	maintained by the Treasurer of State the Governor's Commission on People with
23	Disabilities Fund to be used as follows:
24	(A) Thirty percent (30%) for scholarship awards to persons
25	with disabilities; and
26	(B) Twenty percent (20%) towards educating the public
27	about accessible parking, including without limitation:
28	(i) Public awareness campaigns;
29	(ii) Public service announcements:
30	(iii) Distribution of pamphlets; or
31	<u>(iv) Social media.</u>
32	(2) Seventy percent $(70\%)$ Fifty percent $(50\%)$ of the fines

8	applicant for a van-accessible parking decal; and
9	(B) Verify with a letter from a physician stating that the
10	person for whom the van-accessible parking decal is issued is a person with $\underline{\boldsymbol{a}}$
11	disability that requires the use of a wheelchair, a three-wheeled or four-
12	wheeled scooter, a four-wheeled walker with a seat, or a similar device that
13	is commonly used to transport persons who have limited or no use of their
14	<u>legs.</u>
15	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 27-15-308, concerning special license
16	plates and special certificates to transport persons with disabilities, is
17	amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
18	(f)(1) An owner of a motor vehicle described in § 27-15-303 may apply
19	$\underline{\text{to}}$ the office for issuance of one (1) or more van-accessible parking decal $\underline{\text{to}}$
20	$\underline{\text{be}}$ affixed to each special license plate or special certificate, or temporary
21	$\underline{\text{special certificate issued to the owner, if the applicant, a dependent of the}$
22	applicant, or any individual who depends primarily on the applicant for more
23	than sixty percent (60%) of his or her transportation is a person with $a$
24	disability that qualifies for van accessible parking privileges, as defined
25	<u>in § 27-15-312(a)(2)(A).</u>
26	(2) An applicant whose vehicle displays both a special license
27	plate and special certificate is required to have a van-accessible parking
28	decal affixed to the special license plate and special certificate.

30	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 27-15-310, concerning display of a special
31	license plate or certificate, is amended to add an additional subsection to
32	read as follows:
33	(c) No vehicle shall display a special license plate with a van-
34	accessible parking decal or a special certificate with a van-accessible
35	parking decal unless the vehicle is being used for the purpose of
36	$\underline{\text{transporting the person with a disability for whom the van-accessible parking}}$

1	decal was issued.

3	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 27-15-312(a), concerning exclusive parking
4	privileges for persons with disabilities, is amended to read as follows:
5	(a)(l) A vehicle displaying a van-accessible parking decal, a special
6	license plate, or $\underline{a}$ special certificate, or a temporary special certificate
7	and being used for the actual transporting of a person with a disability is
8	permitted exclusive parking privileges in those areas designated for parking
9	only by persons with disabilities the van-accessible parking decal, special
10	license plate, or special certificate.
11	(2)(A) Except as provided under subdivision (a)(2)(B) of this
12	section, a parking space reserved for a person with a disability that is
13	designated as "van accessible" shall be used exclusively by $\frac{1}{2}$
14	<u>vehicle</u> that:
15	(i) load Loads or unloads unloads a wheelchair, a
16	three-wheeled or four-wheeled scooter, <u>a four-wheeled walker with a seat</u> , or
17	a similar device that is commonly used to transport ${\text{persons}}$ who have $\underline{\text{a person}}$
18	who has limited or no use of their his or her legs; and
19	(ii) Displays a van-accessible parking decal.
20	(B) If the parking lot or parking facility has only one
21	(1) parking space reserved for a person with a disability, then the

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25	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 27-15-315(a), concerning the regulation of
26	signs to enforce the provisions of this subchapter, is amended to read as
27	follows:
28	(a) For the purposes of this subchapter and for the purposes of
29	enforcing any law of this state relating to penalizing <del>owners or operators of</del>
30	vehicles <u>an owner or operator</u> who <del>park</del> <u>parks a</u> vehicle in <u>a</u> spaces
31	space designated for use by <del>persons with disabilities</del> a person with a
