14	(B) An individual providing home and community-based	
15	services;	
16	(3) (4) "Legal representative" means the same as a person	
17	authorized to consent on the principal's behalf under § 20-6-102;	
18	(4) (5) "Patient" means an individual who has a critical medical	
19	condition or a terminal illness and for whom a physician has determined that	
20	a physician order for life-sustaining treatment is consistent with the	
21	individual's goals of care;	
22	(5)(6) "Physician" means an individual who is licensed to	
23	practice medicine or osteopathic medicine in this state; and	
24	(7) "Physician assistant" means a physician assistant licensed	
25	to practice in this state by the Arkansas State Medical Board;	
26	(6)(8) "Physician order for life-sustaining treatment" means a	
27	document containing orders by a physician regarding life-sustaining treatment	
28	and medical interventions in accordance with the wishes of a patient, or if	
29	the wishes of the patient are not reasonably known and cannot with reasonable	
30	diligence be ascertained, in accordance with the best interest of the	
31	patient; and	
32	(9) "Supervising healthcare provider" means a licensed physician	
33	or other authorized independent healthcare provider who has undertaken	
34	primary responsibility for the health care of an individual.

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1	physician orders for life-sustaining treatment, is amended to read as

3	(B) The physician, physician assistant, or advanced
4	practice registered nurse who is serving as the supervising healthcare
5	provider of the patient;
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
