2	7-5-315. Counting votes for unopposed and deceased candidates.
3	(a)(1)(a) As used in this section "nonpartisan municipal office"
4	includes all nonpartisan municipal offices except for the office of district
5	court judge.
6	(b)(1) The votes received by an unopposed candidate for the office of
7	mayor, governor, or circuit clerk shall be counted and tabulated by the
8	election officials.
9	(2) All other unopposed candidates shall be declared and
10	certified as elected in the same manner as if the candidate had been voted
11	upon at the election.
12	$\frac{(b)(1)}{(c)(1)}$ The votes received by any person a candidate for an
13	office that is not a nonpartisan municipal office whose name appeared on the
14	ballot and who withdrew or died after the certification of the ballot shall
15	be counted.
16	(2)(A) If the person candidate received enough votes to win the
17	election, a vacancy in election shall be declared.
18	(B)(i) If the $\frac{person}{candidate}$ received enough votes to
19	qualify for a runoff, the person's candidate's name shall appear on the
20	runoff ballot.
21	(ii) If enough votes are cast for the person
22	candidate to win the runoff, then a vacancy in election shall exist.
23	(d)(1) A candidate for office may withdraw from candidacy after
24	certification of the ballot by filing a written statement that:
25	(A) Is signed by the candidate and acknowledged before an
26	officer authorized to take acknowledgements; and
27	(B) Attests to the candidate's desire to withdraw as a
28	candidate for the office.
29	(2) The candidate withdrawing under this section shall file the
30	written statement under subdivision (d)(l) of this section with the:
31	(A) County clerk if the candidate filed for candidacy with
32	the county clerk; or
33	(B) The Secretary of State if the candidate filed for
34	candidacy with the Secretary of State.
35	(3) The county clerk or Secretary of State shall promptly

3	(e)(1) The votes received by a candidate for a nonpartisan municipal		
4	office whose name appeared on the ballot and who has withdrawn or died after		
5	the certification of the ballot shall not be counted if two (2) or fewer		
6	candidates remain after the withdrawal or death.		
7	(2) If only one (1) candidate for a nonpartisan municipal office		
8	remains after a candidate withdraws or dies after certification of the		
9	ballot, the remaining candidate shall be certified as elected.		
10	(3) If two (2) candidates for a nonpartisan municipal office		
11	remain after a candidate withdraws or dies after certification of the ballot		
12	and:		
13	(A) Only one (1) of the remaining candidates has the most		
14	votes, the remaining candidate with the most votes shall be certified as		
15	<u>elected; or</u>		
16	(B) If more than one (1) of the remaining candidates have		
17	the most votes and the same number of votes, the candidates with the most		
18	votes and the same number of votes shall be certified to the general runoff		
19	election or special runoff election.		
20	(4) If a candidate for a nonpartisan municipal office has		
21	withdrawn or died after certification of the ballot and his or her name will		
22	appear on the ballot but not be counted, notice shall be posted in each early		
23	voting location, polling place, and vote center in a manner that is		
24	reasonably visible to voters which:		
25	(A) Identifies the candidate who has withdrawn or died		
26	after certification of the ballot;		
27	(B) States that the candidate has withdrawn or died after		
28	certification of the ballot; and		
29	(C) Advises voters that any vote entered for that		
30	candidate will not be counted.		
31	(f) If a candidate for the office of mayor or city clerk withdraws or		
32	dies after certification of the ballot, the total number of votes cast in the		
33	election for mayor or city clerk shall be counted and tabulated for		
34	administrative purposes, but the dead or withdrawn candidate shall not be		
35	certified as elected or to a runoff election.		
36	(g)(l) Votes not counted under this section may be tabulated or
