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SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-8-603 is amended to read as follows:

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1	20-8-603. Duties.		
2	(a) The Alzheimer's Advisory Council shall:		
3	(1) Assess the current and future impact of Alzheimer's disease		
4	and other types of dementia on the residents of the State of Arkansas;		
5	(2) Examine the existing industries, services, and resources		
6	addressing the needs of persons living with Alzheimer's disease, their		
7	families, and caregivers; and		
8	(3) Develop a strategy to mobilize a state response to the		
9	public health crisis created by Alzheimer's disease and other types of		
10	dementia.		
11	(b) The council shall include the following in its assessments and		
12	recommendations:		
13	(1) Statewide trends in the number of persons living with		
14	Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia and the needs of those		
15	persons;		
16	(2) The state's role in providing long-term care, family		
17	caregiver support, and other forms of assistance to persons with early-stage		
18	and younger onset of Alzheimer's disease;		
19	(3) State policy regarding persons with Alzheimer's disease and		
20	developmental disabilities;		
21	(4) Existing services, resources, and capacity, including		
22	without limitation:		
23	(A) The type, cost, and availability of dementia services;		
24	(B) The dementia-specific training requirements for long-		
25	term care staff;		
26	(C) Quality care measures for residential care facilities;		
27	(D) The capacity of public safety and law enforcement		
28	agencies to respond to persons with Alzheimer's disease;		
29	(E) The availability of home-based and community-based		
30	resources for persons with Alzheimer's disease, including the availability of		
31	respite care for families;		
32	(F) An inventory of long-term care dementia care units;		
33	(G) The adequacy and appropriateness of geriatric		
34	psychiatric units for persons with behavioral disorders associated with		
35	Alzheimer's and related dementia;		
36	(H) The assisted living residential options for persons		

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1	with dementia; and		
2	(1) State support for Alzheimer's research; and		
3	(5) Needed state policies or responses, including without

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10	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 20-8-604 is amended to read as follows:		
11	20-8-604. Reports.		
12	The Alzheimer's Advisory Council shall present a draft of assessments		
13	and recommendations for meeting the Alzheimer's disease needs in the State of		
14	Arkansas to the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor and the		
15	Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor on or before October 1		
16	of each <u>even-numbered</u> year.
