1	(b) A law enforcement agency shall have a written policy regarding the		
2	investigation of an officer-involved death that involves a law enforcement		
3	officer employed by the law enforcement agency.		
4	(c)(l) The written policy required by subsection (b) of this section		
5	shall require an investigation conducted by at least two (2) investigators,		
6	one (1) of whom is the lead investigator and neither of whom is employed by		
7	the law enforcement agency that employs the law enforcement officer involved		
8	in the officer-involved death.		
9	(2) If an officer-involved death being investigated is traffic-		
10	related, the written policy under subsection (b) of this section shall		
11	require the investigation to use a crash reconstruction unit from a law		
12	enforcement agency that does not employ a law enforcement officer involved in		
13	the officer-involved death being investigated, except that the written policy		
14	for a state law enforcement agency may allow an investigation involving a law		
15	enforcement officer employed by that state law enforcement agency to use a		
16	crash reconstruction unit from the same state law enforcement agency.		
17	(3) Each written policy under subsection (b) of this section may		
18	allow an internal investigation into the officer-involved death if the		
19	internal investigation does not interfere with the investigation conducted		
20	under this subsection.		
21	(d)(1) In an expeditious manner, the investigators conducting the		
22	investigation under subsection (c) of this section shall provide a written		
23	report to the prosecuting attorney having jurisdiction in the county in which		
24	the officer-involved death occurred.		
25	(2)(A) If the prosecuting attorney having jurisdiction determines		
26	that there is no basis to prosecute the law enforcement officer involved in		
27	the officer-involved death, the investigators conducting the investigation		
28	under subsection (c) of this section shall publicly release the written		
29	report described in subdivision (d)(1) of this section.		
30	(B) However, before publicly releasing the written report		
31	described in subdivision (d)(l) of this section, the investigators shall		
32	delete any information that is not subject to disclosure under the Freedom o.		
33	Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.
