21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended*  
24 *to add a new section to read as follows:*

25 *25-1-121. Alternative or secondary address for state communications*  
26 *through the mail – Law enforcement officers.*

27 *(a) A person who is employed primarily as a law enforcement officer*  
28 *may elect to use an alternative or secondary address, such as a post office*  
29 *box, to receive all of his or her communications sent by a state agency*  
30 *through the mail.*

31 *(b) The secondary or alternative address must be in the same county*  
32 *and, where practicable, same voting precinct as the law enforcement officer's*  
33 *primary place of residence.*
