18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
19 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 THAT Representative Jean is authorized to introduce a bill which as
22 introduced will read substantially as follows:

24 "For An Act To Be Entitled
25 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW; AND FOR OTHER
26 PURPOSES.

28 Subtitle
29 TO AMEND THE REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW.

31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

33 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue
34 Stabilization Law.

35
36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-5-302(9)(B), concerning revenues for the



1 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, is amended to add an additional
2 subdivision to read as follows:

3 (vi) Civil penalties paid or recovered as set out in § 2-
4 24-108(d)(2).

5
6 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's fiscal
8 laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year, and that if the
9 current legislative session is extended so that the ninety-day period ends
10 after July 1, 2016, the changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency
11 is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
13 on July 1, 2016."
