13	TO URGE THE ACTIVATION OF CLOSED
14	CAPTIONING ON TELEVISION MONITORS IN
15	PUBLIC VENUES.

18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY
19	OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20	
21	WHEREAS, in the interest of eliminating isolation and segregation and
22	encouraging the gathering and participation of all individuals, it is sound
23	policy to promote full and equal communication access to all; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, televisions are increasingly used in venues open to the
26	general public, including without limitation hospital waiting rooms, medical
27	offices, medical centers, restaurants, small businesses, health clubs, social
28	recreation facilities, airport lounges, and more; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, hearing loss is a part of life for many individuals in the
31	United States; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, a 2011 study by Johns Hopkins University researchers estimated
34	that approximately one (1) in five (5) Americans who are twelve (12) years of
35	age or older have some type of hearing loss in one (1) or both ears that
36	affects their ability to communicate and receive information; and

2	WHEREAS, hearing loss is one of the most common disabilities in the
3	United States; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, closed captioning displays the audio portion of a television
6	program in text form on the television screen, providing access to news,
7	entertainment, and information for individuals who are deaf or hard of
8	hearing; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission requires video
11	programming shown on television or over the internet after being shown on
12	television to be closed captioned; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, all televisions are now built to support closed captioning;
15	and
16	
17	WHEREAS, activating closed captioning on television monitors located in
18	public venues promotes full communication access for people who are deaf or
19	hard of hearing; improves comprehension for viewers who are learning English
20	as a second language; provides access to news and information for everyone in
21	what may be a noisy environment; improves comprehension of on-screen dialogue
22	that may be spoken very quickly or mumbled, spoken in another dialect, or
23	muffled by background noise; and assures full information is shared with all
24	citizens during emergencies,
25	
26	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-
27	THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
28	
29	THAT the House of Representatives urge the activation of closed
30	captioning on television monitors located in public venues during hours when
31	the venue is open to the general public and the monitors are in use.
