18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 THAT Senator Teague is authorized to introduce a bill on behalf of the  
22 Joint Budget Committee which as introduced will read substantially as  
23 follows:

25 "For An Act To Be Entitled  
26 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW; AND FOR OTHER  
27 PURPOSES.

29 Subtitle  
30 TO AMEND THE REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW.

32 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
33

34 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue  
35 Stabilization Law.

1           SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-5-302(9)(B), concerning revenues for the  
2 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, is amended to add an additional  
3 subdivision to read as follows:

4                     (vi) Civil penalties paid or recovered as set out in § 2-  
5 24-108(d)(2).

7           SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
8 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's fiscal  
9 laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year, and that if the  
10 current legislative session is extended so that the ninety-day period ends  
11 after July 1, 2016, the changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency  
12 is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the  
13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective  
14 on July 1, 2016."
