7 **HOUSE RESOLUTION**

8 TO EXTEND THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE

10 EXCEEDING FIFTEEN (15) DAYS UNDER ARKANSAS
11 CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE 6, § 19, FOR THE PURPOSE OF
12 CONSIDERING LEGISLATION TO CREATE AN INCOME TAX
13 CREDIT FOR CERTAIN FULL-TIME LAW ENFORCEMENT

18 TO EXTEND THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY
19 SESSION OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL
20 ASSEMBLY FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING
21 FIFTEEN (15) DAYS TO CREATE AN INCOME TAX
22 CREDIT FOR CERTAIN FULL-TIME LAW
23 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

26 WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, provides that, after
27 the General Assembly has disposed of the business set forth in the Governor's
28 proclamation to convene an extraordinary session, the General Assembly may,
29 by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to both houses, remain
30 in session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of
31 transacting other legislative business; and

33 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has disposed of the matters set forth in
34 the Governor's proclamation calling the Second Extraordinary Session of the
35 Ninety-Third General Assembly,



1 NOW THEREFORE,
2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

5 THAT the Second Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General
6 Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to the
7 business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene the Second
8 Extraordinary Session.

9
10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Second Extraordinary Session of the
11 Ninety-Third General Assembly is extended as provided in Arkansas
12 Constitution, Article 6, § 19, and shall remain in session for a period not
13 exceeding fifteen (15) days for the purpose of considering legislation to
14 create an income tax credit for certain full-time law enforcement officers.
