11 FOR PRODUCING THE FOOD AND FIBER THAT IS ESSENTIAL TO  
12 THE HEALTH AND SECURITY OF THE CITIZENS OF THIS STATE  
13 AND PEOPLE THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

17 COMMENDING ARKANSAS FARMERS, RANCHERS,  
18 AND FORESTERS FOR THEIR VITAL  
19 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SECURITY AND  
20 ECONOMIC WELLBEING OF THE STATE AND THE  
21 NATION.

24 WHEREAS, nearly twenty percent (20%) of Arkansas's economy is based on  
25 food, fiber, and forestry; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, two-thirds (2/3) of Arkansas's counties rely heavily on  
28 farming and forestry as their economic base; and

29  
30 WHEREAS, agriculture and related activities and industries provide more  
31 than two hundred eighty thousand (280,000) jobs and employ one (1) in every  
32 six (6) Arkansans; and

33  
34 WHEREAS, agricultural pursuits in this state generate a value in excess  
35 of twenty billion dollars (\$20,000,000,000) to the Arkansas economy annually,  
36 which contributes to Arkansas's stable and well-balanced economy; and

2           WHEREAS, Arkansas ranks in the top twenty-five (25) states in  
3 production of twenty-three (23) agriculture commodities, including being a  
4 top-five producer of rice, catfish, baitfish, broilers, turkeys, grain  
5 sorghum, and cotton; and

7           WHEREAS, Arkansas has more than forty-four thousand (44,000) farms on  
8 thirteen million eight hundred thousand (13,800,000) acres and more than  
9 nineteen million (19,000,000) acres of forestland; and

11           WHEREAS, Arkansas ranks fifteenth in agricultural cash receipts in the  
12 nation; and  
13

14           WHEREAS, farmers, ranchers, and foresters provide the bulk of the  
15 state's wildlife habitat, practice sound environmental stewardship, and  
16 supply community leadership throughout rural Arkansas; and  
17

18           WHEREAS, the agricultural community contributes a substantial portion  
19 of the revenues that finance state and local services to all of Arkansas's  
20 citizens; and  
21

22           WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers, ranchers, and foresters are deserving of  
23 public commendation and appreciation,

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL  
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
28

29           THAT the House of Representatives expresses sincere appreciation to  
30 Arkansas farmers, ranchers, and foresters for their outstanding contributions  
31 to the economy of the state and nation and to the wellbeing of the people and  
32 commends them for their dedication to the wise utilization of our resources.
