21 WHEREAS, Dr. Trent P. Pierce of West Memphis, Crittenden County,
22 Arkansas, is serving the Arkansas General Assembly today as the Doctor of the

25 WHEREAS, Dr. Pierce was appointed in January 1997 by Governor Mike
26 Huckabee to serve on the Arkansas State Medical Board; and

28 WHEREAS, Dr. Pierce currently serves as Chairman and Congressional
29 District Member of the Arkansas State Medical Board; and his current term
30 expires on December 31, 2012; and

32 WHEREAS, Dr. Pierce survived an attack on his life by a disgruntled
33 doctor seeking revenge on the board, leading to an even stronger conviction
34 to serve the State of Arkansas through continued service on the board
35 following the attack; and



1 WHEREAS, Dr. Pierce is a leader in his community and respected by all
2 whom he encounters; and

4 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Eighth General
5 Assembly commends Dr. Pierce for his service as Chairman of the Arkansas
6 State Medical Board and Doctor of the Day to the Arkansas General Assembly,
