20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 WHEREAS, the Cold War was a period of tension between the Soviet Union
24 and the United States after World War II; and
25

26 WHEREAS, historians do not agree on the dates of the Cold War, but the
27 period is generally considered to span the time between the establishment of
28 the Truman Doctrine in 1947 and the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991;

31 WHEREAS, a Strategic Air Command program was established in 1946, at
32 the Blytheville Air Force Base, which was renamed Eaker Air Force Base in
33 1988, located in Blytheville, Arkansas, to oversee the United States Air
34 Force's long-range bombing forces and to conduct long-range offensive
35 operations in any part of the world; and
